



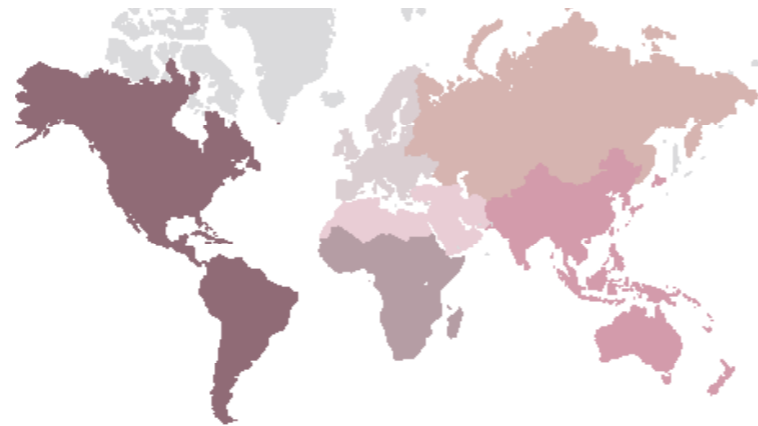

Next Generation Democracy

The **NGD process** will include a series of meetings in different regions of the world, as well as on-line contributions and exchanges, that will serve to complete and fine-tune **NGD templates** that will in turn serve to create the **NGD matrix**, which will be constantly updated. The project becomes, in this sense, a cross-learning exercise based on inputs provided directly by relevant stakeholders from different regions.

The **NGD template** will structure a series of reports for the following **six regions**:



Sub-Saharan Africa, Asia-Oceania, Americas, Post-Soviet Eurasia, Wider Europe, and Broader MENA.

The basic configuration of the NGD template comprises:

Within each track the template will cover:

Three Tracks

- People and communities
- Business and the Economy
- Resources and Ecosystems

Three dimensions

- Values and Institutions
- Access and Inclusiveness
- Management and Policies

The project is unique in that all three tracks, thus all three dimensions covered under each of them, will be analyzed through the lens and from the perspective of **democratic governance**.

The NGD project aims to be a participatory and collaborative process and, as such will work within an operational scheme consisting of a Steering Committee, Executive Coordinators, Task Force and Regional Teams. Members of the Task Force, the project's principal content engine will include:

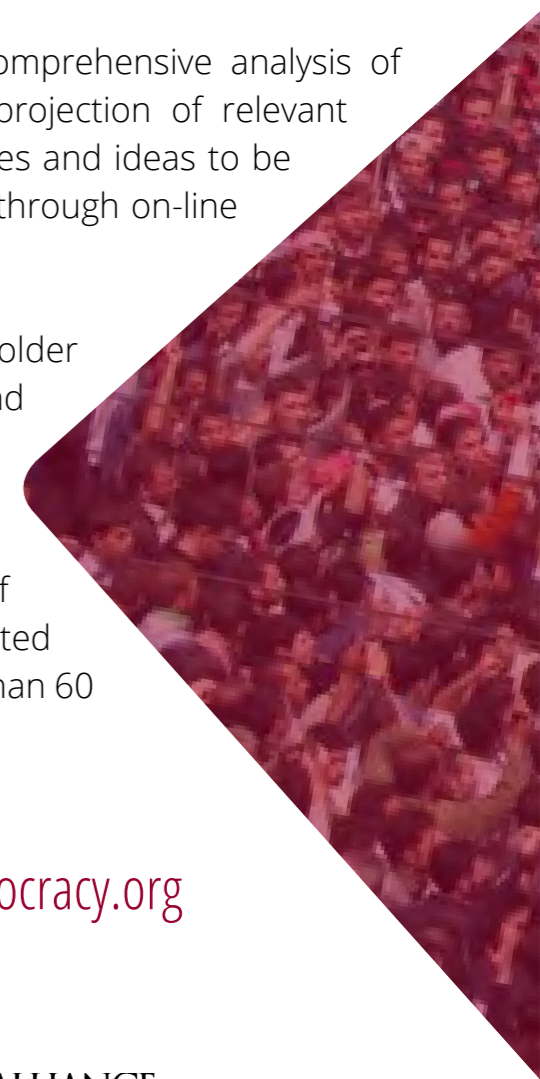
